## TIMELINE OF EVENTS PERTAINING TO THE KINGDOM

1Cor 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, [and] become the firstfruits of them that slept. 1Cor 15:21 For since by man [came] death, by man [came] also the resurrection of the dead.

1Cor 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

1Cor 15:23 But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming.

1Cor 15:24 Then [cometh] the end, when he shall have delivered up **THE KINGDOM** to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

1Cor 15:25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

1Cor 15:26 The last enemy [that] shall be destroyed [is] death.

1Cor 15:27 For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under [him, it is] manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.

1Cor 15:28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.

Note: Here we see the time line for the great events pertaining to the Kingdom of God.

1. Christ rose from the dead first so he is called the 'firstfruits' of those who 'slept' (were dead).

2. All people who belong to Christ in this present world will be made alive (resurrected) in the first resurrection at his (second) coming.

\* Rev 20:6 Blessed and holy [is] he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

3. Then he will reign until he has put down all enemies. Rev 20:4,6 tells us that he will reign for a thousand years.

\* Rev 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and [I saw] the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received [his] mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

4. The last enemy that he shall destroy is death. This shall be accomplished at the end of the thousand years by the second resurrection of all people who never had their chance in this life to repent and be offered eternal life. There will be no one left in the graves. After their period of judgment all these people shall either be given eternal life in the Kingdom of God or cast into the lake of fire for the second death from which there is no resurrection.

\* Rev 20:5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished...

\* Rev 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is [the book] of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Rev 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Rev 20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

Rev 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

5. After the lake of fire consumes all of the wicked in the second death, it will then consume the earth and the heavens.

\* 2Pe 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

6. The New Heavens and New Earth shall be created.

\* 2Pe 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

\* Rev 21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

7. Then after all enemies have been destroyed, Jesus will deliver the kingdom up to God the Father and God himself shall descend from Heaven and dwell with mankind.

\* Rev 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God [is] with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, [and be] their God.
